This training series is designed for Community Councils, Community Development Corporations, Neighborhood Business Associations, and other community groups who want to build their skills and knowledge and grow their capacity to create successful, positive community change.

The series offers three tracks based on the current capacity of your organization. It provides opportunities for neighborhoods just getting started to communities with high functioning organizations who want to hone their skills and take on more. These tracks are informed by the experiences of the Place Matters initiative and the learnings from LISC, CBI, and IIN from their work with communities.

Many of the sessions will include some of our own local experts, your friends and neighbors. There is lots of good work going on in Cincinnati and we plan to highlight our own best practices and create a local network of practitioners who can support each other.

Sessions are organized by tracks: **Strategic** Development, Planning, and Partnerships. Sessions in each track are designed to build on one another, so sign up for as many or as few as you like, depending on your needs and interests. Plan to bring a team from your community if you can, and use these sessions as a way to do some work while you are learning.
